

## My River in the Valley

### Rules

- Stay safe. Do not put yourself or anyone else at risk of danger.
- The competition is open to children and young people including all schools and college communities and those that are home educated and any other young people's community organisations within the River Holme catchment area. There is a map of the catchment area on our website [www.riverholmeconnections.org](http://www.riverholmeconnections.org).
- If your photo includes people, you must check you have their consent. Photographs which include those of people under 18 years old must be accompanied by written permission from the parent, guardian, or carer of the person for those photographs to be submitted.
- By entering this competition, you consent for River Holme Connections to use your photo in additional online content and printed material.
- The photo must be original.
- Only one entry per person so choose wisely!

### How to enter

- Get creative...take a photo of "My River in the Valley" and capture the beauty of our rivers and the wildlife and human activities they support. Photo must be taken within the River Holme catchment area.
- Take your photo, complete an entry form, and email it to [info@riverholmeconnections.org](mailto:info@riverholmeconnections.org). All entries must include your name, age, location of photo, address, where you attend school or college and most importantly contact details. Add a sentence about where your photo was taken and why this is your "River in the Valley".
- There are three age categories:
  - 4 - 8 years old
  - 9 - 13 years old
  - 14 - 18 years old
- If you are under 13, please ask a parent / guardian / carer to complete the entry on your behalf. The details you provide will be used for this competition only and will not be used for any other purpose.
- Competition will close at **5pm on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022**. Any late entries will not be accepted.

### Judging and notification of the winners

- Our Ambassador Shona Searson (Channel 5's the Yorkshire Vet) and internationally renowned local artist Ashley Jackson will judge the three winners for each category. The judge's decision will be final.
- Winners of each category will be notified by email or telephone on or before **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2022**. The winners will be invited to attend an event on the morning of Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2022 where their prizes will be presented. There will be three cash prizes for each of the three age categories: 1<sup>st</sup> prize - £15, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize - £10 and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize - £5.
